Overnight Oats

Peanut Butter Banana Oatmeal

- -1 tbps peanut butter
- -1/2 banana
- -1 tsp honey/maple syrup
- -1 tsp hemp seeds

Apple Pie Oatmeal

- -1/4 cup diced apples
- -1/4 tsp cinnamon or pumpkin spice
- -1 tsp honey/maple syrup

Very Berry Overnight Oatmeal

- -1/4 cup mixed berries like blueberries, raspberry, strawberries, etc.
- -1 tsp maple syrup/honey
- -1 tbsp jam

Chocolate Oatmeal

- -1/4 cup chopped strawberries
- -1 tpsp mini chocolate chips
- -2 tbsp chopped nuts
- -1 tsp chocolate syrup (optional)

Directions:

Add the ingredients mentioned above on top of the oatmeal base and refrigerate overnight. Cover the container with a lid. You can add the toppings the previous night or when you are serving it.
